Award Description CDBG-R funds will be used for hard development costs associated with activities that promote energy efficiency and conservation through rehabilitation or retrofitting of existing buildings.	
The City will target neighborhoods that have the highest proportion of low-income households and sub-standard structures. The proposed projects are located within the Mid-Town Community Redevelopment Area. These census tracts have been most impacted by the recession and the proposed projects will augment the CDBG projects that have been completed under the Rehabilitation Program. Residents in this area are low to moderate income households. The homes will be modified to incorporate energy efficiency features, therefore	

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assisting the residents with long-term energy costs savings.

1) REHABILITATION & PRESERVATION:
CDBG-R funds will be used to rehabilitate or reconstruct homes on same site of low-moderate income households on our existing applicant list. Reconstruction will occur when the cost of rehabilitation exceeds 65% of the cost to replace the home.

2) PLANNING & ADMINISTRATION:
CDBG-R funds will pay reasonable program administration costs related to the planning and execution of the activity listed above. This includes costs related to staffing for overall program management, coordination, monitoring, reporting and direct & indirect costs.
