HOME SECURITY CHECKLIST



1. Are all exterior doors secured with a single cylinder deadbolt lock with a minimum of a 1 inch throw?



2. Are exterior doors made of solid core construction (including the door from the garage into the house)?



3. Is there a wide angle peephole viewer on the front door?



4. Are sliding glass doors secured with auxiliary locks or pins?



5. Are the screws in the sliding glass door track backed out to prevent the door from being lifted off?



6. Are windows secured with auxiliary locks, thumb screws, or pins?



7. Have you eliminated all jalousie windows?



8. Do exterior lights illuminate all entrances to your home?



9. Is shrubbery and landscaping kept trimmed so a criminal can't hide in your yard?



10. Do you keep your garage door closed at all times?



11. Do you keep your doors and windows closed and locked, even when you are home?



12. Do you report suspicious persons or activity to the police immediately?



13. Are your valuables marked with your Florida driver license number?



14. Do you have a record of your valuables complete with make, model, and serial numbers?



15. Are emergency numbers posted near your phone?



16. Do you have a family emergency plan and supplies?
