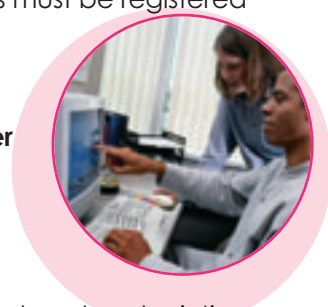
A value-centered youth development program for middle school youth; Choices addresses age appropriate etiquette for real life situations, exposes youth to resource people, and provides subject-related field trips.
