# Stomper's Neighborhood Insider!

This month in Stomper's Neighborhood Insider we will be highlighting the Citizens Police Academy



From August 14<sup>th</sup> to November 13<sup>th</sup> 2014, the Lakeland Police Department Hosted the Citizens Police Academy.

The Citizens Police Academy (CPA) is designed for selected community-oriented citizens. The CPA includes detailed information on police topics such as uniformed patrol, special investigations, crime scene investigation, SWAT, K9 and many other areas of interest. Also included in the curriculum is a tour of the police station and communications center. A firearms familiarization course is also covered to one Saturday where participants will be given a chance to test their skills at the firing range.

On November 13, 2014, the Lakeland Police Department held the graduation for our Citizens Police Academy. We had 44 graduates from the 15 week academy. These graduates are then welcomed into our Alumnae group that helps with the volunteering needs of the police department.
