This month's Stomper's Neighborhood Insider will be highlighting the Smoke Alarm Campaign partnership and the 130<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of LPD!



The Lakeland Police Department is celebrating and honoring 130 years of Law Enforcement to the City of Lakeland. In commemoration of the 130<sup>th</sup> anniversary, the Lakeland Police Department designed a special purpose badge. You might see an officer proudly wearing one until the end of 2015 at which point they will be decommissioned. The badges were made at no cost to the Police Department and are available to employees for self-purchase. Throughout 2015 we will be celebrating in many ways, stay tuned for upcoming events.

On Monday, February 2, 2015, teams from Lakeland Police Department, Lakeland Fire Department, American Red Cross, and volunteers worked together on the Fire Safety Campaign from the American Red Cross. The groups met at Fire Station 3 located at 110 W. Buena Vista and dispersed to homes in the area. Residents were educated on fire safety, crime prevention and free smoke alarm testing. A new smoke detector was installed if one was not present or replaced if defective. This area was targeted because statistically there is a higher prevalence of fires and life threatening emergencies. Overall the groups installed approximately 80 detectors.
