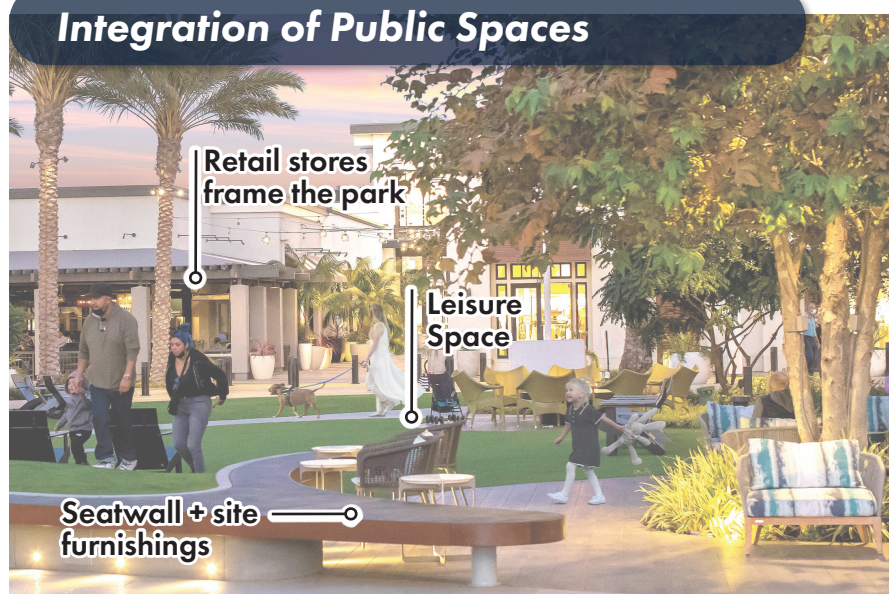
Pedestrian Oriented Mainstreet



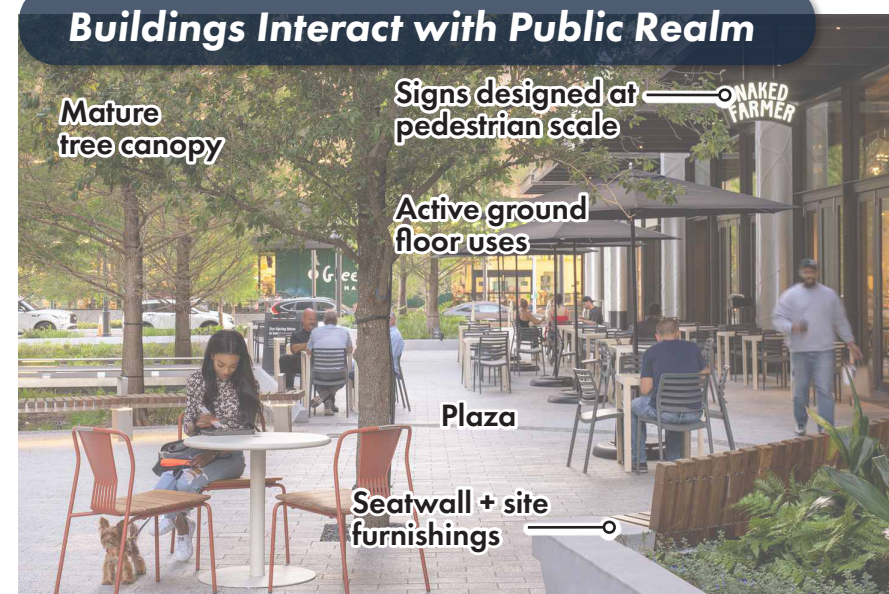
Mix of Uses and Amenities
