## CRIMINAL HISTORY

A form letter will be picked up with your application. You are responsible for ensuring that this is completed and a check for \$15.00, made payable to FDLE, is enclosed and sent to Tallahassee.

## TESTING

All students must complete the PCC (Test of Adult Basic Education, Level A, Form 5) and achieve a minimum of 11th grade (11.0) proficiency in: Reading, Math, Language and Spelling skills before you are given an application. This **MUST** be completed before you are given an application. Those who fail to attain the required level will not be allowed to enter the academy. The TABE test is given in the Learning Resource Building, Teaching Computer Center on the Winter Haven campus, only.

## PHYSICAL EXAMINATION

A complete physical examination by a licensed physician must be submitted. An EKG and/or a physician administered stress test is required for all applicants. The form in the application must be utilized.

**AN UNSATISFACTORY PHYSICAL MAY RESULT IN REJECTION.**

## EQUIPMENT REQUIREMENTS

**The Criminal Justice Academy provides all books and printed materials for your training.**

**WEAPON:** A revolver or semi-automatic handgun, in safe serviceable condition (generally a 38 Special or 9mm Semi-Automatic).

**Ammunition:** 1000 rounds of wadcutter, semi wadcutter reloads or factory loads (approx. 50 rounds/box)  
50 rounds of shotgun ammunition:  
25 rounds of birdshot #7 - #9 (used for practice)  
20 rounds of 00 buckshot (9 pellets)  
5 slugs

**Cartridge Holders:** Spare cartridge holders for ammunition are required  
Two speed loaders for revolvers  
Three magazines for automatic pistols

**Holster:** A waist safety holster suitable for the handgun used. No cross draw or shoulder holster will be permitted.

**Cleaning Kit:** A cleaning kit for your particular weapon. To include: cleaning, solvents, lubricants, bore brushes, cleaning rods, etc.

**UNIFORM:** A dark blue utility uniform will be worn by all students starting the first day of training.

**Shoes:** Black, shineable shoe

**Socks:** Black or dark blue

**Belt:** Dark blue

The uniforms are available from the College Bookstore, approximately \$37.00 set. Hats will be provided by the academy.

**PHYSICAL TRAINING EQUIPMENT:** Gray sweat pants, sweat shirt, tee shirt, and blue running shorts.
