1. Minutes from the January 21, 2010 (P. Wilson, M. Lynn) Historic Preservation Board meeting were reviewed and approved.
2. Old Business:
 - a. The Federal Building, 124 S. Tennessee Avenue. The State Historic Preservation Officer (SHPO) has been asked by the City to make a determination if partial demolition of the building will be allowed. Prior to making a decision, the SHPO has asked for drawings to detail how the original building will be renovated should demolition of the 1931 addition be approved.
3. New Business:
 - a. The design of the FSC 125 year celebration banners was presented to the Board. These banners will be placed on the historic light poles on Ingraham Avenue on the campus during homecoming and a portion of the remaining year.
 - b. National Trust for Historic Preservation alerted all members about the proposed historic preservation budget cuts by the Federal government. Save America's Treasures program will not be funded. National Recreation and Preservations budgets would be cut by \$17 million and eliminate the Preserve America grants. Staff will draft a letter for the Board to send to our representatives in Congress asking them to return funding for these programs in the Federal budget. In addition, staff will re-send the email that can generate a similar letter to our representatives in Congress.
