## **ELIGIBILITY:**

Applicants for internships must meet each of the following eligibility conditions:

- Must be currently enrolled at an accredited degree-granting institution and have successfully completed their sophomore year.
- Must express an interest in governmental relations relating to community development and neighborhood revitalization.
- Must be a legal citizen of the United States.
- Must be majoring in government related fields, i.e. urban planning, political science, etc.

## **JOB DESCRIPTION:**

Internship assignments may occur in a variety of areas pertaining to community development. Assignments will be based on the needs of the community and the programs in which mentors are working. Some assignments may involve field experiences, under the supervision of a mentor. Analytical thinking and problem solving capabilities are a must. Interns may be required to retrieve data and utilize internet sources to assist in solving problems involving Lakeland's Neighborhoods. Statistical skills, solid writing ability, and strong interpersonal communication skills are a necessity.
