GENERAL DESCRIPTION OF CLASS:

Provides assistance to the Greens Superintendent in the development and professional management of fine golf turf. Serves as liaison between the Sales and Grounds Maintenance division to ensure best playing conditions. Responsible for the maintenance division.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

1. Assists in supervising the daily golf course maintenance to include the planning and cutting of turf grasses, maintenance of putting greens, tees, fairways, roughs and bunkers.
2. Sets and implements chemical fertilizer programs.
3. Repairs motorized and mechanical equipment.
4. Assists in the supervision and maintenance of pumps, irrigation and drainage systems and the proper use of chemicals and pesticides.
5. Provides administrative reporting and follow up.

ADDITIONAL RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Performs related work as required.

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS & ABILITIES:

1. Considerable knowledge of construction and maintenance techniques used on golf course grounds.
2. Knowledge of the golf game.
3. Ability to prepare a budget.

WORKING ENVIRONMENT/CONDITIONS:

Medium to heavy work that involves walking, standing, stooping, lifting, digging, pushing or raising objects and also involves exerting between 20 to 50 pounds of force on a recurring basis and 50 to 100 pounds of force on an occasional basis.

The job requires normal visual acuity, field of vision, hearing, speaking, color perception, sense of smell, depth perception, and texture perception.

QUALIFICATIONS (EDUCATION, TRAINING, AND EXPERIENCE):

1. Graduation from a four (4) year accredited college or university with a degree in agronomy/Horticulture/Plant/ Soil Sciences preferred.
2. One (1) year previous experience in mechanical, electrical and plumbing activities.
3. An equivalent combination of education and experience determined to be directly related to the foregoing specific requirements may be substituted.
4. Completion of City University Level one (1) or completion within twelve (12) months

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS:

1. Must possess a valid state of Florida driver's license.
2. Must maintain a valid home telephone number.
3. May be required to work overtime, or alternate hours, as necessary for the efficient operation of the department. Position may be designated as Mission Critical by Department Director.
