PROPOSED RESOLUTION NO. 07-058

A RESOLUTION RELATING TO PUBLIC WORKS; ESTABLISHING FEES FOR COLLECTION OF SOLID WASTE AND REFUSE COMMENCING OCTOBER 1, 2007 PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City commission of the City of Lakeland, Florida, finds that it is in the best interests of the City and its Public Works customers to revise and adopt fees for the collection of solid waste and refuse, to be effective October 1, 2007; and

WHEREAS, Section 86-43 of the Code of the City of Lakeland, Florida provides that fees for collection of solid waste would be established by resolution of the City Commission.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LAKELAND, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. This resolution is adopted pursuant to Chapter 86-43 of the Code of the City of Lakeland.

SECTION 2. Commencing October 1, 2007, the City Commission does hereby find that the fee collections of solid waste shall be as follows:

Residential Customers:

The monthly fee for residential service for dwelling units individually billed for service will be ~~\$15.00~~ \$15.75 per dwelling unit if served by a rear loading collection vehicle, and ~~\$44.38~~ \$11.95 per dwelling unit if served by a commercial type container. Additionally, each single family dwelling unit will be billed \$1.50 monthly and each multi-family residential dwelling unit will be billed \$1.25 monthly for recycling service.

Residential customers will be provided with once a week collection of *Regular Yard Trash*, in unlimited quantities, at no charge.

Residential customers shall be allowed one *Bulk Yard Trash* collection, up to one twenty (20) cubic yard truckload, per each calendar year quarter. Additional, full or partial *Bulk Yard Trash* collections requested, in excess of the one quarterly collection, will be billed to the residential customer at the rate of ~~\$10.40~~ \$10.92 per cubic yard for yard trash collection, with a minimum charge of ~~\$23.09~~ \$24.24 per pickup.

As used herein, the following definitions shall apply:

Regular Yard Trash means leaf, grass and shrubbery clippings and tree trimmings not exceeding five (5) inches in diameter. *Regular Yard Trash* shall be either containerized or properly bundled and tied with each container or bundle not exceeding forty (40) pounds in weight; trimmings from *Regular Yard Trash* shall be cut into lengths not to exceed five (5) feet, or five (5) inches in diameter. Leaves and grass clippings shall be placed in plastic bags or other containers with contents not to exceed forty (40) pounds.

Bulk Yard Trash means wood matter including tree branches larger than five (5) feet and greater than five (5) inches in diameter.

Commercial Customers:

(1) *Containers provided by the City.* The fee basis shall be ~~\$4.41~~ 4.63 per cubic yard of container volume per collection. The monthly fees for container sizes and collections per week are:

(2) *Containers owned by the customer.* The fee basis shall be ~~\$3.62~~ 3.80 per cubic yard of container volume per collection. The monthly fees for container sizes and collections per week are:

(3) *Compacted solid waste and refuse.* Rates for solid waste and refuse in commercial containers which has been compacted by commercial compacting units shall be three times the rate for containers with uncompacted solid waste or refuse.

(4) *Yard trash collections.* There shall be a charge of ~~\$10.40~~10.92 per cubic yard, with a minimum charge of ~~\$23.09~~24.24, for each collection of yard trash from commercial customers.

(5) *Containers.* The minimum charge for a commercial container shall be ~~\$24.12~~ 25.33 per month.

(6) *Commercial bin and storage room.* The fee basis shall be ~~\$24.80~~26.04 per cubic yard for up to one cubic yard of waste material collected per collection. The fee basis for each additional cubic yard collected shall be ~~\$8.28~~8.69 per cubic yard collected per collection. The monthly fees for volumes collected and collections per week are:

(7) *Standard commercial cans.* The fee basis shall be \$1.341.38 per can per collection for a minimum of two cans. The fee basis for each additional can shall be \$1.061.11 per can collected per collection. The monthly fees for number of cans serviced and collections per week are:

(11) *Trip Fee.* The fee basis shall be ~~\$13.86~~ 14.55 per trip for extra dumps in addition to the rate per cubic yard for container, cardboard, and tire services.

Roll-off Containers

Roll-off containers provided by the City shall be charged for that service. The fee basis shall be as follows:

- (1) *Container Rental.* The fee basis shall be \$2.06 per day for container rentals not serviced within a 30 day period.
- (2) *Delivery Charge.* The fee basis shall be \$53.75 for initial container delivery.
- (3) *Container Collection and Disposal.* The fee basis shall be \$118.25 per collection plus disposal charges.
- (4) *Return and Replacement – Containers Owned by the Customer.* The fee basis shall be \$32.25 per trip.
- (5) *Miscellaneous Trip.* The fee basis shall be \$32.25 per trip.

Providers of a privately franchised roll-off container within the City limits agree to remit to the City of Lakeland 10% of gross revenue for roll-off containers serviced within the City. A duplicate certified copy of Applicant's fillings for the preceding month shall accompany the remittance of 10%.

SECTION 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
