




Permit fees are non-refundable once the application has been processed.

- Select appropriate PERMIT Subtype from the dropdown
 - o FIREWORKS, PYROTECHNICS or FLAME EFFECTS
- In Short Description, enter description IN ALL CAPS (ex: LKLD FLYING TIGERS POST GAME SHOOT; FIREWORKS FOR INDEP CELEBR ON LK MIRROR; PYROS SHOWS FOR [YEAR] SUN N FUN; FLASH POT ON STAGE, 1 MIN USE IN PERFORM)
- In Job Value, enter the Contract price amount.



- Do not check the Property Owner box, this will be filled with the information on file.
- Check the contractor box, if not already checked.

Fireworks

- 1. Copy of Federal Explosives License/Permit.
- 2. Copy of Certificate of Liability Insurance.
- 3. Copy of Operator's Driver's License.
- 4. Operator's Resume, Curriculum Vitae, or proof of experience.
- 5. Fireworks display site plan, to include display firing location, fall-out radius based on largest shell, audience location, and applicable distances.
- 6. Shell listing, to include size, quantity, and fall-out radius.
- 7. If multiple shoots, provide list of shows including dates, times, and duration.

Pyrotechnics

- 1. Copy of Federal Explosives License/Permit.
- 2. Copy of Certificate of Liability Insurance.
- 3. Copy of Operator's Driver's License.
- 4. Operator's Resume, Curriculum Vitae, or proof of experience.
- 5. Show diagram, to include pyrotechnic firing location, required clearances, audience location, and applicable distances.
- 6. List of products used in show, to include size, quantity, and required clearances.
- 7. If multiple shoots, provide list of shows including dates, times, and duration.

Flame Effects

- 1. Copy of Certificate of Liability Insurance.
- 2. Copy of Operator's Driver's License.
- 3. Operator's Resume, Curriculum Vitae, or proof of experience.
- 4. Show diagram, to include flame effect location, required clearances, audience location, and applicable distances.
- 5. List of products used in show, to include size, quantity, and required clearances.
- 6. If multiple shoots, provide list of shows including dates, times, and duration.





Note: It is the responsibility of the contractor to print the permit once it is approved, along with the approved plans and comments, and make them available on the job site prior to work beginning and through the duration of the job.
