The Adopt-A-Lake Program

Increased urbanization, improper or excessive use of fertilizers, herbicides and pesticides, litter bugs, yard waste, pet waste, leaking or poorly maintained septic systems, household chemicals, auto washing and auto fluids cause polluted storm-water runoff that effects the health of our area lakes.

Adopt-A-Lake Activities

Lake Clean Up Activities

Volunteers participate in the removal of litter from the shoreline of their favorite Lakeland lake. Equipment, garbage bags and gloves are provided to each volunteer. When a volunteer or group commits to a lake for a specified amount of time, the volunteer or group will sign a Letter of Intent and the city will supply and install a sign of recognition in honor of the volunteer or group adopting the lake.

Volunteers install educational plaques on storm drains to inform the public that waste dumped into storm drains go directly into our lakes.

Volunteer Monitoring

Volunteer monitoring through Florida LAKEWATCH program, sponsored and coordinated through the University of Florida's Institute of Food and Agricultural Sciences. Volunteers are trained on proper collections methods for monthly lake water quality samples. Samples are sent to the University of Florida for analysis and reports explaining results are sent to the volunteers.
