**PROPOSED ORDINANCE NO. 97-59**

**AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO CODE ENFORCEMENT;  
AMENDING SECTION 2-94 OF THE CODE;  
AUTHORIZING CODE ENFORCEMENT BOARD TO  
ENFORCE POLK COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 93-06, AS  
AMENDED, KNOWN AS THE POLK COUNTY  
STORMWATER QUALITY MANAGEMENT  
ORDINANCE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF  
LAKELAND, FLORIDA:**

**SECTION 1.** Section 2-94 of the Code of the City of Lakeland is amended  
to add subsection (19) as follows:

**Sec. 2-94. Jurisdiction.**

The code enforcement board shall have the authority to enforce the following  
Code provisions and ordinances, where a pending or repeated violation continues to exist:

- (1) Occupational licenses and permits, chapter 18 and 78;
- (2) The building code;
- (3) The fire prevention codes adopted in section 42-26;
- (4) The plumbing code;
- (5) The Land Development Code;
- (6) The electrical code;
- (7) The housing code;
- (8) The mechanical code;
- (9) Animals, chapter 10;
- (10) Solid waste, chapter 86;
- (11) Health and sanitation, chapter 46;
- (12) Abandoned property, section 54-86 et seq.;

- 1 (13) Lakes, chapter 58;  
2 (14) Skateboard ramps, section 90-51 et seq.;  
3 (15) Regulations for the storage of motor homes, boats and trailers, chapter 66;  
4 (16) Ordinance numbers 2685 and 2687, relating to satellite dishes; and  
5 (17) Ordinance number 2957, relating to meter accessibility;  
6 (18) Alarm systems, section 34-29.  
7  
8 (19) Polk County Ordinance No. 93-06, as amended and known as the Polk  
9 County Stormwater Quality Management Ordinance.

10 **SECTION 2.** All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are  
11 hereby repealed.


12 **SECTION 3.** If any word, sentence, clause, phrase, or provision of this
