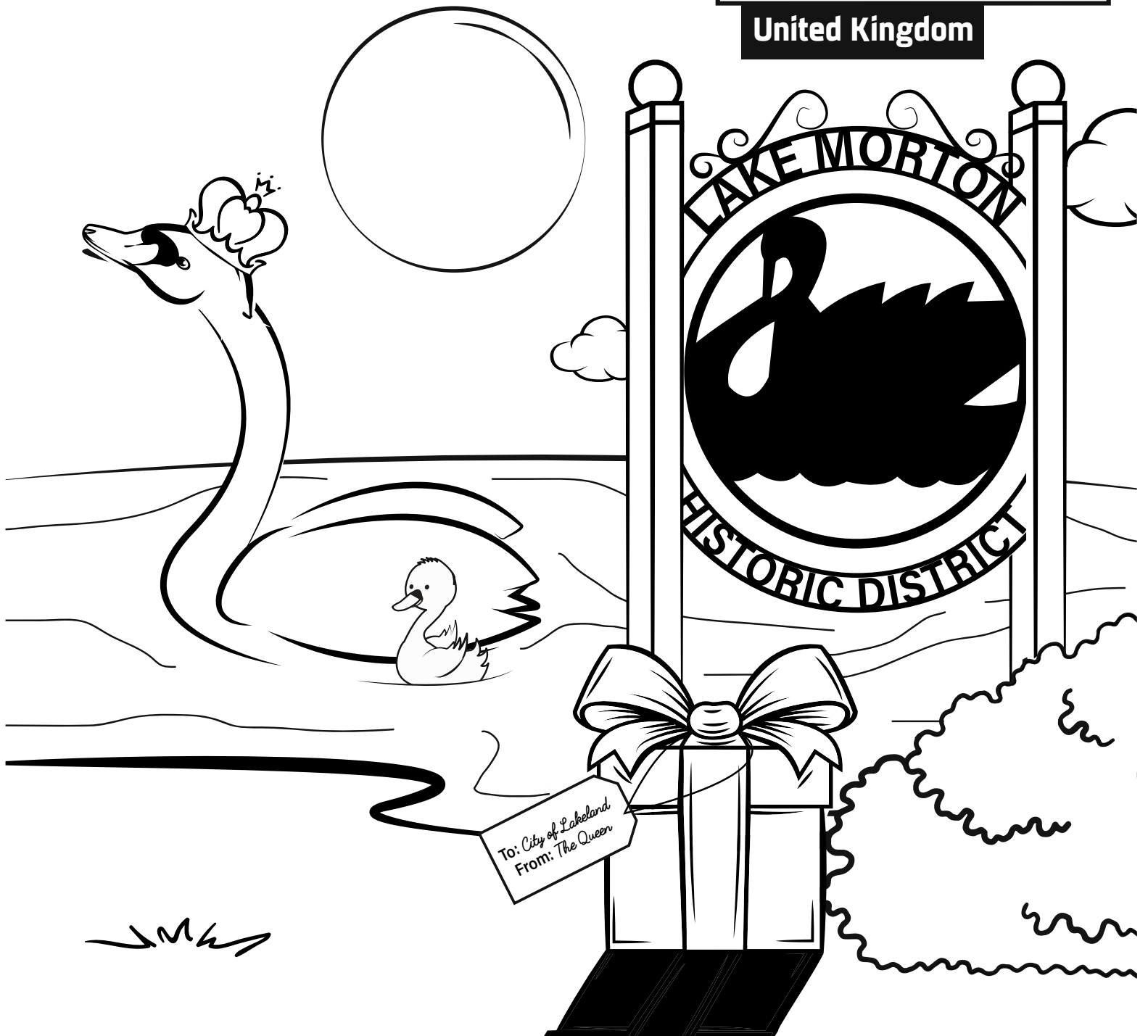

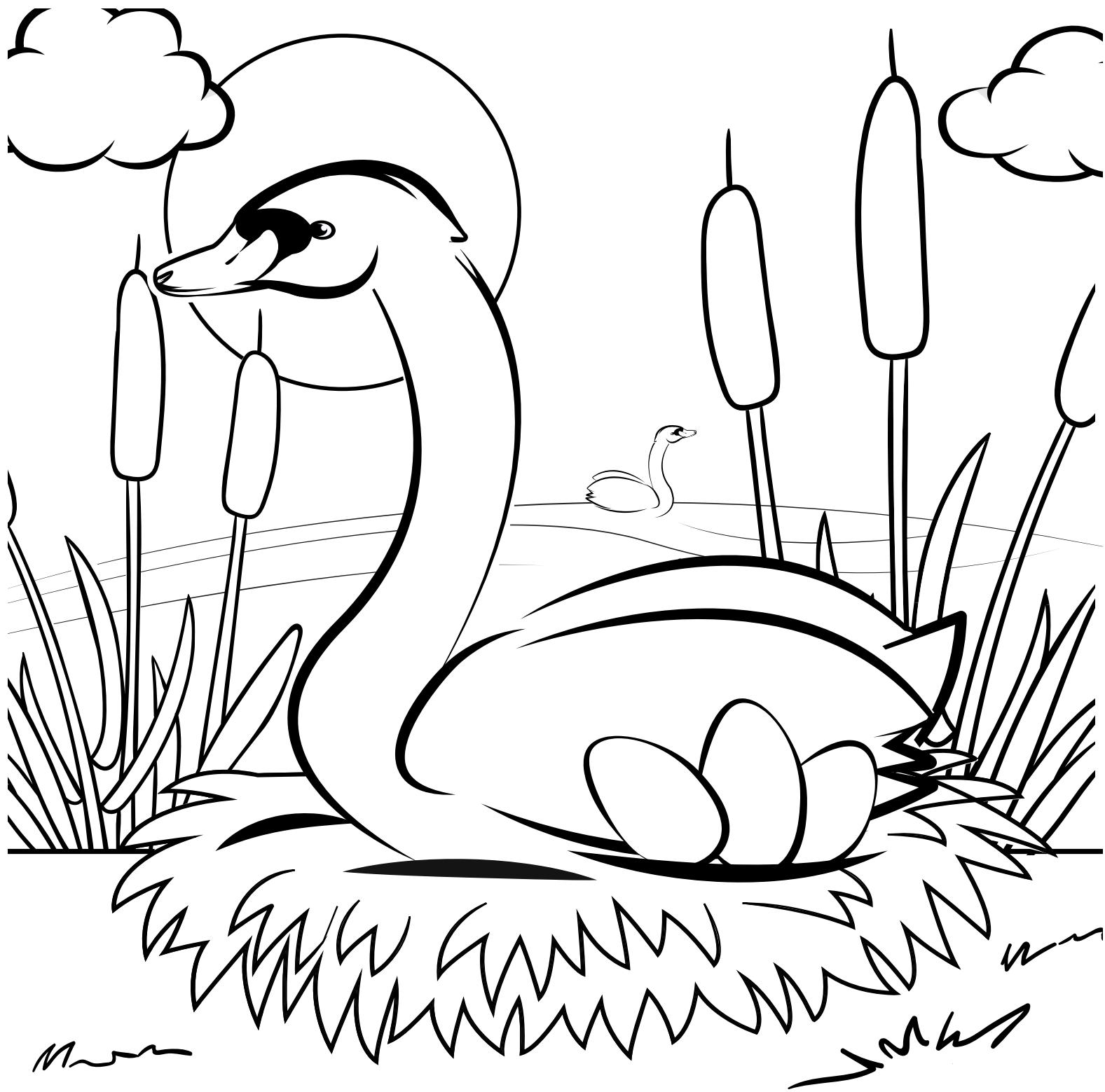
SWAN HISTORY

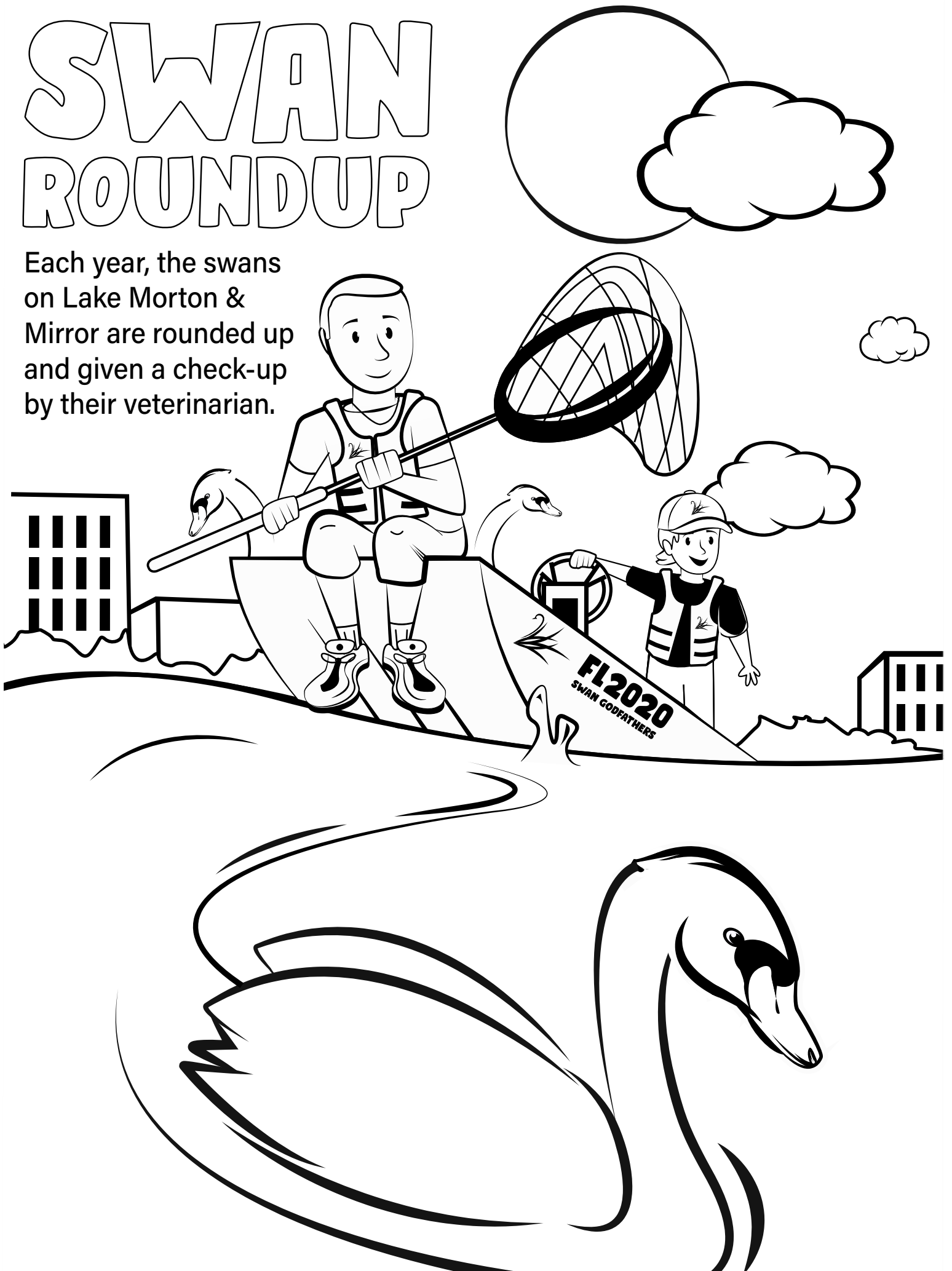


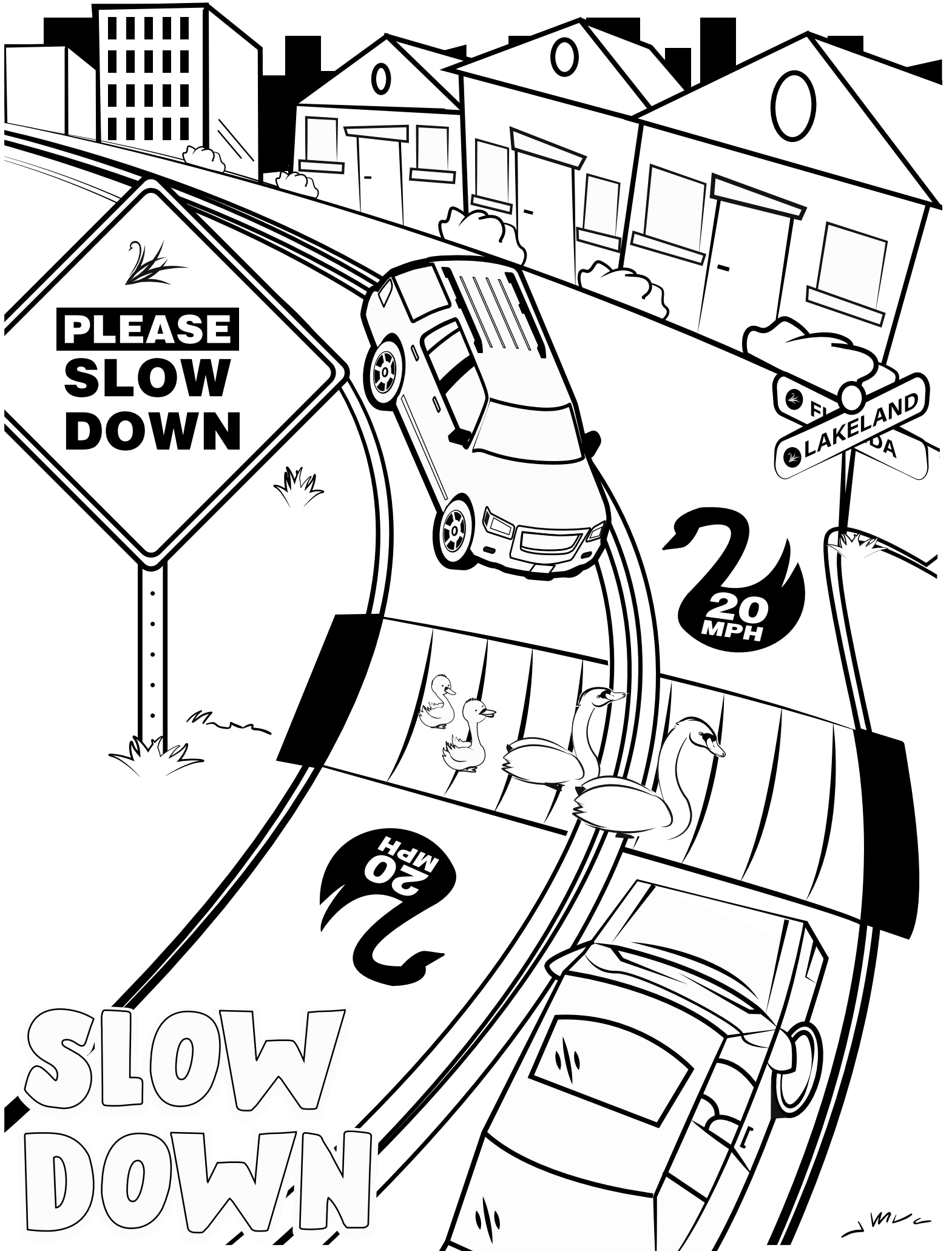
FEEDING TIME
