A special-called meeting of the City Commission is scheduled for September 21, 2026 at 8:15 a.m. This meeting will be convened in open session in the City Commission Conference Room, where the City Attorney will advise of the need to discuss pending litigation as listed on this Agenda and will request that the Commission recess into a closed session in accordance with §286.011(8), Florida Statutes. The entire session will be recorded by a certified court reporter. Following the closed session, the City Commission will reconvene in open session to consider settlement of the litigation, at which time public comment regarding the matter will be taken.

If a person decides to appeal any decision made by the City Commission with respect to any matter considered at this meeting, he or she will need a record of the proceedings, and, for such purpose, he or she may need to ensure that a verbatim record of the proceedings is made, which record includes the testimony and evidence upon which the appeal is to be based.
