Warm Winter Wishes! Hope y'all had a great Christmas and Best Wishes for a

happy New Year.

With that cold spell at Christmas time, quite a few of my plants got hit. As much as I don't enjoy looking at them like that (they are ugly), we don't want to cut them back yet. If we do they will start to bud out, and if we get more cold weather they will get bit and the cold may go down to the roots and kill the plant. The dead leaves and burnt foliage will protect the plant if it gets cold again.

Now is a good time to plant some trees. The best time to plant a tree depends on your region. Fall is a good time. Our soil doesn't freeze so it's still not to late. The benefits of planting a tree now are varied. This time of the year we have cooler weather and less rain fall, so the roots can acclimate itself to heat and droughts. Add two or three inches of mulch in a ring around the tree, but not touching the trunk. Water is very important make sure to water after planting, and as needed. 
