

FIRE PERMIT EXTENSION/RENEWAL

Pursuant to the provisions of the Florida Fire Prevention Code, NFPA 1: 1.12.6.8, the AHJ shall have the authority to grant an extension of the permit time period upon presentation by the permittee of a satisfactory reason for failure to start or complete the work or activity authorized by the permit.

Permits may expire, or become null and void, if the work authorized by the permit is not commenced within six months after issuance, or if the work authorized by the permit is suspended or abandoned for a period of six months after the work is commenced. Work is considered in active progress when the permit has received an approved inspection at least every 180 days.

The applicant must receive at least one approved inspection every 180 days after permit issuance, or the permit will expire. Permits remaining expired for 180 days or more may be turned over to Code Enforcement. Permits that have been expired for OVER 180 days may not be renewed except under extenuating circumstances and as approved by the Fire Marshal. Otherwise, a new permit application, all fees, and compliance with all current codes and regulations will be required.
