This checklist is provided to assist customers in submitting complete permit applications and plans, which smooths and speed the permit approval process. While the checklist is thorough, it is not exhaustive and does not apply to every permitted project type. **Contractors:**Please note that application for this type of permit must be made through eTRAKIT, with plans submitted through ePlan.

☐ Acceptable Site Plan	One of the following may be used from which to create an acceptable site plan.
	1. A copy of an existing survey, or

	the building or location is clearly visible. The Property Appraiser's website
	(www.polkpa.org) is a source for aerials, lot dimensions and the "pic" report
	shows building dimensions, or
	3. A neatly hand drawn or computer generated site plan is acceptable.

	□ Street address
	□ Property dimensions with property lines
	□ Abutting streets and names
	☐ Existing structures and dimensions (required for wall signs only)
	□ Easements
	□ Proposed or existing ground sign locations with distances from property lines.
	Include a measurement from the inner edge of sidewalk to the leading edge of the sign.
	The minimum setback is <i>typically</i> 5 feet from the property lines.
