PROPOSED RESOLUTION NO. 24-065

A RESOLUTION RELATING TO THE CITY OF LAKELAND WASTEWATER SYSTEM; MAKING FINDINGS; ADOPTING A UNIFORM SCHEDULE OF MONTHLY WASTEWATER SERVICE CHARGES; PROVIDING FOR SURCHARGES FOR ABNORMAL STRENGTH WASTES OF COMMERCIAL/INDUSTRIAL USERS; PROVIDING FOR WASTEWATER IMPACT FEES; ESTABLISHING MISCELLANEOUS CHARGES; MAKING A DETERMINATION THAT REVENUES WILL BE SUFFICIENT TO OPERATE A FINANCIALLY SELF-SUPPORTING WASTEWATER UTILITY; REPEALING RESOLUTION 5707; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Chapter 102-UTILITIES of the Code of the City of Lakeland, Florida provides that a Uniform Schedule of Charges be established to define the applicable wastewater fees, rates, and charges, including sewer connection charges, wastewater impact charges, standard rates for sewer services and surcharges, and additional charges to be imposed within the City of Lakeland's wastewater service territory; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 102-Utilities requires that the Uniform Schedule of Charges be sufficient to provide the necessary funds for operation and maintenance, replacement costs, capital improvements and debt service of the City's wastewater system; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission on April 6, 2020 commissioned a comprehensive "Water and Wastewater Utilities Cost of Services Study" and a "Water and Wastewater Impact Fee Study" by Raftelis Financial Consultants, Inc. of Maitland, Florida; and

WHEREAS, the Water and Wastewater Utilities Cost of Services Study has been reviewed and updated annually, while an update to the Impact Fee Study was completed in 2023, and the rates, fees and charges necessary to provide a financially sound and self-

supporting wastewater utility have been identified; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 102 of the Code of the City of Lakeland, Florida stipulates that the Uniform Schedule of Charges, particularly the amounts and effective dates, be defined and updated from time-to-time by resolution of the City Commission;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LAKELAND, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. This resolution is adopted pursuant to Chapter 102 of the Code of the City of Lakeland, Florida.

SECTION 2. The City Commission does hereby find that the Uniform Schedule of Charges, incorporated herein, sets forth fair and reasonable rates and charges to provide for the use, or reasonable availability for use, of the services and facilities of the Lakeland Wastewater System by each user receiving wastewater service and is hereby adopted. For commercial and industrial customers, wastewater billing volumes shall be based upon their monthly potable water consumption, unless other approved wastewater measurement methods are approved. Commercial and industrial customers with unique situations or supplemental wastewater generation activities may be required to install and maintain flow measurement/sampling systems approved by Lakeland Water Utilities. Residential customers with separate irrigation water sources will have monthly wastewater billing volumes based upon their monthly potable water consumption. Residential customers whose potable water service includes irrigation demands will have their monthly billing volumes capped at 12,000 gallons per dwelling unit for purposes of computing the volume charge component.

SECTION 3. The City Commission does hereby find that the connection charge for

each connection to the Wastewater Facilities, as outlined in the Code of the City of Lakeland, shall be as set forth in the Uniform Schedule of Charges, incorporated herein.

SECTION 4. The City Commission does hereby find that the surcharges or additional charges for abnormal strength wastes of commercial/industrial users, as outlined in the Code of the City of Lakeland, shall be as set forth in the Uniform Schedule of Charges, incorporated herein.

SECTION 5. The City Commission does hereby find that the fees for industrial monitoring of abnormal strength discharge of commercial/industrial users, as outlined in the Code of the City of Lakeland, shall be as set forth in the Uniform Schedule of Charges, incorporated herein.

SECTION 6. The revenues expected to be generated and the anticipated expenses for operation and maintenance, replacement, and debt service of the Wastewater System as proposed for adoption by the City Commission within the operating budget for the fiscal years beginning October 1, 2024 and ending September 30, 2027, are as follows:

SECTION 7. The City Commission does hereby find that the revenues generated by the rates and charges established for the wastewater system are sufficient to cause the wastewater system to be a financially self-supporting wastewater utility.

SECTION 8. Resolution 5707 and any other resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict with this resolution are hereby repealed.

SECTION 9. This resolution shall be effective upon date of passage. The Uniform Schedule of Rates will be effective as follows:

All rates, fees and charges shall be effective for all bills rendered on or after the effective date set forth in the Uniform Schedule of Charges, incorporated herein Exhibit "A."

SECTION 10. If any word, sentence, clause, phrase or provision of this Resolution, for any reason, is held to be unconstitutional, void, or invalid, the validity of the remainder of this Resolution shall not be affected thereby.
